
What is the difference between radians and degrees?



Mathquarium

Radians: One full circle = 360° Label the 1° angle:




Degrees: One full circle = 2π radians Label the angle measuring 1 radian:

$$360^{\circ} = \underline{\hspace{1cm}}$$
 radians

$$180^{\circ} = \underline{\hspace{1cm}}$$
radians

Label 1 radian and 1° on the image to the right.
